GOOD PRICE FOR PRUNES THIS YEAR

R. L. Gile, Buyer for Willamette Prune Association, Says Crop in France and Oregon Will Be Light.

R. L. Gile, buyer for the Willamette Prune Association and manager of the Umpqua Valley Prune Association, of Douglas county, was in this vicinity yesterday buying prunes. He states that prices for prunes will be high this year, and on this supposition he is contracting for them at four and five cents. The reason for this is that the crop in France promises to be light, and the California product will only be about 60 per cent of the usual yield. While the Oregon crop will produce a yield of only about eighty per cent, this is very fortunate, since, according to Mr. Gile, the prunes will be of such larger grades that the growers could even at average prices net more than with a bigger crop. The fruit in larger grades is also easier handled. Lane county is not a prune county, not because its climate is not adapted to the raising of the fruit, but because other things are so much more profitable without five or six years of waiting. Most of the orchards here are five-acre tracts.

NEWS NOTES FROM COTTAGE GROVE

E. O. Tobey, one of the principal owners of the LeRoy mine in Bohemia, came up from Eugene last week to look after matters connected with the mine.

C. M. Collier, county surveyor, went to Bohemia Monday with a crew of men to do some surveying on the LeRoy property.

The school election yesterday passed off quietly. There are about 300 electors in the district, but only 59 cared to exercise their prerogative. J. M. Isham received 29 and Oliver Veatch 26 for the office of director and J. K. Barrett was re-elected Clerk. There is not much interest taken in school elections, which is to be deplored, as it is one of the most important we hold.
