ALBANY GETS IRRIGATION EXPERIMENT

EUGENE PEOPLE DID NOT GIVE ENGINEER STOVER PROPER ENCOURAGEMENT, HE SAYS

Site Selected for Government Experiments South of Linn County City and Work Has Already Commenced—Alfalfa, Vetch and Clover will Be Watered.

A. P. Stover, irrigation engineer for the United States department of agriculture, has secured a site near Albany for his experiments in irrigation instead of Eugene, as at first planned, and the work of conducting the experiments there has actually begun.

The Guard learns from an authoritative source that Mr. Stover has commenced work with his experiments on a 130-acre tract of land just south of Albany, where the Lebanon railroad branches off from the main line and bordering on the Willamette Valley Company's power canal, called the Santiam ditch, from which the water for the irrigation work will be obtained. Though the water is more easily obtained there than at the site first selected here by Mr. Stover, the soil is of a poorer grade and has been badly treated, and so is in bad condition to start with. However, the reason for changing the scene of operations from Eugene to Albany, it is said, is that the people of this city and the farmers in the vicinity of the proposed experimental site did not seem to care to co-operate with the engineer in the work.

Begin This Week.

The Guard learns that it is the intention of Mr. Stover to turn the water on the land chosen for the experiments this week. A patch of vetch will be irrigated to see if it is possible to raise a second crop. A tract has been sown with clover and alfalfa expressly for these experiments, and it will be watered to ascertain the possibilities with these crops.

While Eugene people seemed to be uninterested in the project Albany took hold of the matter at once with the result that this tract of land was secured and satisfactory arrangements for obtaining water were soon made.

Having commenced so late with the experiments it is not expected that much can be done this year to prove the value of irrigation in the valley, but things will be got in shape so that by another year very good results are expected to be obtained.

TRIMMING SHADE TREES.

NOTICE TO SHEEP OWNERS

The new sheep inspection law requires that all sheep in Oregon shall be dipped by August 1, 1907. Any sheep not dipped at that date must be seized and dipped at the owner's risk.

Owners can save expense by clubbing together and using the same vats and corrals. Any standard sulphur and lime or sulphur, lime and tobacco dip may be used, but must be prepared and used under the supervision of a state or federal officer; and no other dipping will be recognized. Where tobacco dip is used, 16 pounds of sulphur must be added to 100 gallons of prepared dip.

After the vat is sufficiently filled, one-half gallon of dip will be required for each sheep—that is, with good drainage. Lambs must be dipped.

Any persons who hinders or obstructs a deputy in the performance of his duty subjects himself to a fine of from \$100 to \$500.

All deputies are under bonds and are instructed to enforce the law to the letter.

Any owner or owners wishing to arrange a test case should communicate with Dr. W. H. Lytle, Pendleton, Oregon. Such tests have been won by other states.
