FINAL ORDERS FOR MILITIA ENCAMPMENT

Oregon's national guard will occupy five different camps at this year's encampment. Final orders, distributing the entire guard, have been received here from the headquarters of the Adjutant General, W. E. Finzer. Five picked companies go to Fort Stevens and three to Fort Columbia to participate in the United States Artillery and Coast defense maneuvers. Part of the Third Infantry goes to Seaside, the artillery goes into a separate camp on the coast and the rest of the guard will have its outing near Roseburg.

The disposition of troops, as announced by General Finzer, is as follows:
Roseburg, July 20 to 29.—Headquarters First Separate Battalion, Companies B and D, of the Separate Battalion, Company G Third Infantry and Separate Companies E and F.

Seaside, August 6 to 14.—First Battalion of Field Artillery. This period will be devoted to artillery target practice.

Fort Stevens, Wash., July 6 to 15.—Companies A, C and K, Third Battery and Companies A and C, Separate Battalion.

Fort Columbia, Or., July 6 to 15.—Companies B and M, Third Infantry.

Seaside, July 8 to 16.—Companies D, E, F, H, I, and L, Third Infantry, Separate Company G and the Hospital Corps.

Lieutenant-Colonel Poorman will command the Oregon troops in the Coast defense maneuvers Colonel McDonnell will be in command of the infantry at Seaside, Captain Welch will command the battery camp and Major Yorlan will probably be in command at Roseburg.

Lawrence, receiver of the land office, says there is no immediate relief in sight, as the Interior Department has made no provision for extra clerks needed to clear away the hold-up entries.

Time and again we have urgently requested the Interior Department to provide for extra clerks so that these entries could be disposed of," said Receiver Lawrence, "but each time we have been informed that there are no funds available for such a purpose. While Mr. O'Brien is a competent inspector, an inspector is not required in this case; we need extra clerks, and have needed them for months, but just when we are going to get them would be difficult to prophesy. Inspector O'Brien merely repeated the work of former inspectors, approving entries that long ago underwent investigation and should have been expedited to patent. Now, I suppose, instead of allowing us clerks, the Interior Department will detail still another inspector to go over the work that has already been done."
