RAILWAYS TO BE MADE TO COMPLY WITH LAW

The state railway commission, it is understood is planning to file a complaint against the railway companies in this state and will later hold a hearing on matters relative to the conditions and adequacy of waiting rooms and depots, also to ticket offices, requiring that they shall be opened thirty minutes before the arrival and departure of trains except in the case of delayed trains. The commission will also ask that the platforms at the stations and depots be properly lighted; that the depots be provided with pure drinking water and with other accommodations required by the traveling public. It is also rumored that a formal complaint is to be lodged against the Southern Pacific company relative to the continued delay in the arrival of the No. 12 train.

NEW BUILDINGS NEARING COMPLETION

The new library building at the university will be finished from present reports in two or three weeks, and the girls' club building in a little less time. The library is a structure of pleasant appearance, especially on the inside. The building is made of pressed brick. The roof is especially noticeable, for a late party to Spencer Butte stated that the vermillion roof was the plainest single object in the vicinity of Eugene.

The girls' club is nicely situated, and will be a fine home for about twenty girls. The Tau Pi sorority building at the corner of Alder and Thirteenth has also been begun.
