EIGHTEEN MEN AT THE PAVING PLANT STRIKE

DEMAND HIGHER WAGES, BUT MANAGER CHIPMAN REFUSES AND HIRES CREW OF NEW MEN.

Men Are Getting What Old Crew Asked For—There Will Be Little If Any Delay in Paving Operations. Street Car Track Ready For Paving for Two Blocks.

Eighteen men employed at the Warren Construction Company's rock crusher at the paving plant and at the quarry quit work this morning and demanded higher wages. Manager Chipman refused to accede to their demands, but he is paying the new men that sum. He anticipates no further trouble along that line, as he is now picking his men and will hire none but those whom he thinks will stay with him.

Street Railway Work.
The men at work on the street railway line have been busy surfacing up the track that has been laid and tamping the gravel between the ties preparatory to laying the pavement. It was found this morning that the track was three inches too far to the west and some little time was taken to move it. Foreman Hiterback says he will begin work on the block between sixth and seventh streets tomorrow, as that portion of the track between the depot and sixth street will be entirely completed and ready for the pavement by tonight.

LEFT HIS PROPERTY TO HIS FATHER

The will of Arthur Comegys, who died at his home in Eugene on August 31, 1906, was admitted to probate today. The probable value of the estate is \$2000. He leaves to his wife, Edna Pearl Comegys, the sum of \$50, and the remainder of his property to his father, Presley Comegys. T. G. Hendricks is named as executor. The will was executed on August 21, 1906.

TELEGRAPHIC NEWS IN BREVITY FORM

The drunken carousal of five men in the saloons of Troutdale, Oregon, 13 miles east of Portland, resulted in the burning of the finest block in the town. They upset a kerosene lamp in a room in the annex to the Troutdale hotel and this started the fire. One of the men, W. J. Smith, was burned to cinders, and Richard Nicholson, severely burned. Among the buildings burned were the Troutdale hotel, the Union House, Harlow, Blazer & Harlow, general store; S. S. Logan's store building; Larson Bros.' saloon; Weinhard estate, saloon and livery stable; Aaron Fox, postoffice building; Robert White's building; Reynolds' butcher shop. Loss, \$30,000; insurance, \$11,000.

It is reported that a Cuban uprising had been planned for July 12, but Governor Magoon nipped it in the bud.

The body of Phillip Standley, the Camas Valley, Or. (Douglas county), rancher, who disappeared three months ago in the mountains, while on the way to marry Miss Bushnell, in Olatia, has been found hanging in a tree near where the last trace of him was found. He evidently committed suicide on the eve of his wedding.

BIG MONEY IN BRITISH COLUMBIA TIMBER LANDS
