**BRIDGES SUED FOR COMMISSION ON TIMBER SALE**

Attorney S. D. Allen, of this city, today instituted suit in the circuit court against J. T. Bridges, ex-registrar of the United States land office at Roseburg, to recover \$360 commission on the sale of some timber land.

Attorney Allen alleges that in July, 1906, the defendant gave him authority to sell 720 acres of timber land in township 17, south of range 4 east, for \$20 per acre, at any time within twenty days from August 12, 1906, the defendant agreeing to pay the plaintiff 2 1/2 per cent commission. He alleges that on August 14, 1906, he found a purchaser for the land in the person of Chas. H. Chick and his associates, Constantine Morton and Everett P. Lewis, who were willing to take the land at that price, but defendant wrongfully refused to convey the land to them and wholly repudiated the sale and sold the land to other persons.

The plaintiff asks for a judgment of \$360, together with interest from September 5, 1906.

It will be remembered by Guard readers that Mr. Chick entered suit against Mr. Bridges last fall to compel the latter to deliver the deeds to these lands, and the case is still in the courts.

**DIED.**

At his home three miles northwest of Eugene on the Irving road, July 31, 1907, at 5:15 a. m., John Kemery, aged 82 years. The cause of death was paralysis and other infirmities due to old age. He leaves a wife and nine children. The deceased had lived in this county for the past eight years, being engaged in fruit raising. The funeral will be held Friday at 10 a. m. at the family home and the remains will be interred in the L. O. O. F. cemetery.

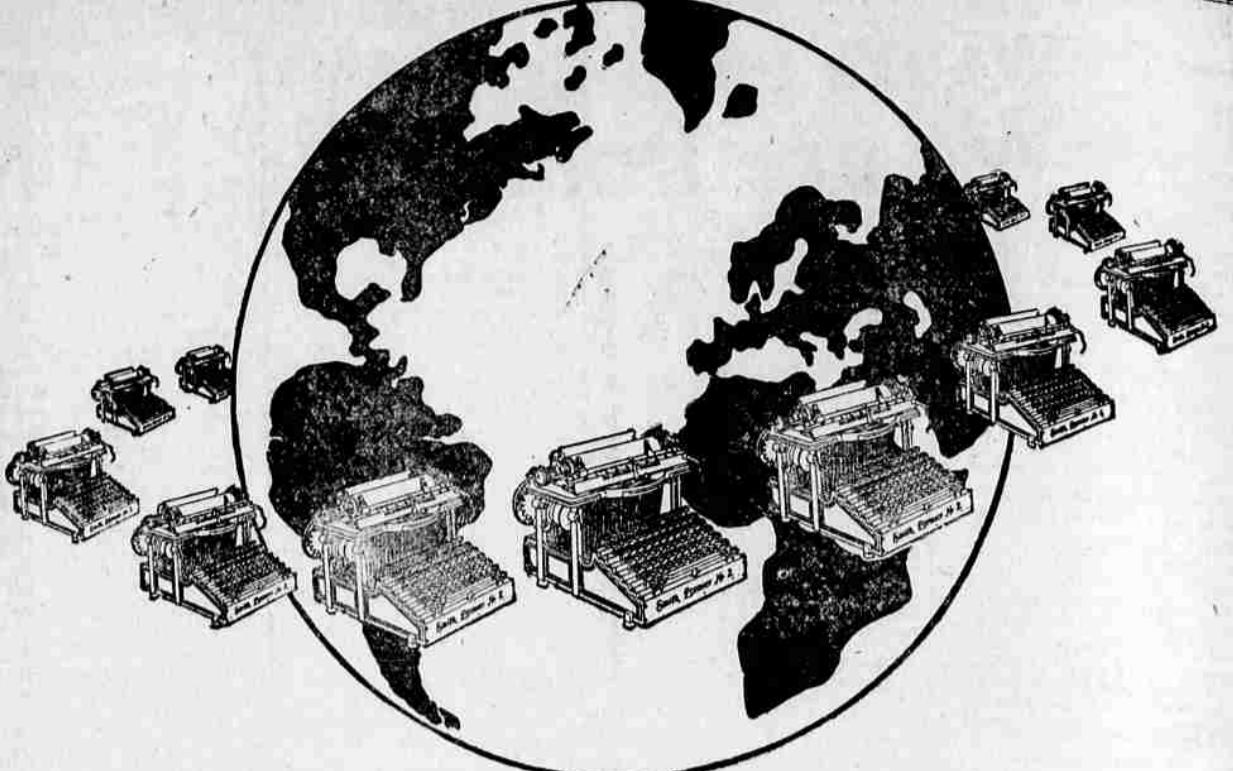
