### OLD FOLKS' HOME WILL OPEN ON OCTOBER 1

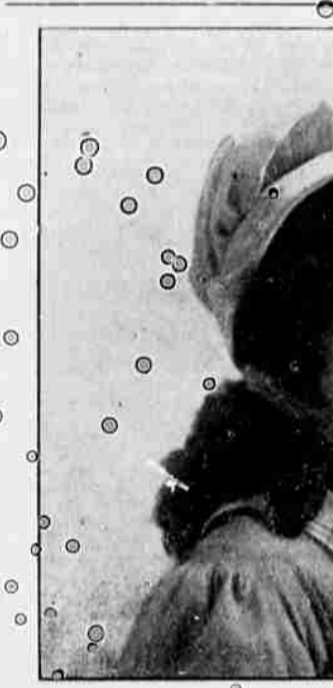

### SIUSLAW RAILROAD FUND FOR ELECTRIC LINE

C. S. Frank, the committee work in an hour this morning and succeeded in raising \$10,000 in subscriptions, some of the Carver subscribers doubling the sum previously given, some increasing it 50 per cent, and others 25 per cent. The committee did not go out this afternoon, but will continue the work tomorrow. It is desired to raise \$50,000, the same amount raised for the Carver road, and it is thought that it can be done easier than before.

The proposition as set forth in the subscription paper is as follows: Know all men these presents that Whereas, A. Welch and his associates propose to build, equip and run a railroad from Eugene, Oregon to Portland, Oregon, and said railroad is to extend through the Willamette valley, and is to be propelled by electricity or steam; and Whereas, the undersigned are residents of Eugene and Lane county, Or., and believe that said road will be of great benefit to the said undersigned in subscribing stock in said railroad; and Whereas, the Southern Pacific company is the only company operating a railroad between Portland and Eugene, and the citizens of Eugene and Lane county are subjected to the will and control of one railroad, and said railroad is not extending to the business which said locality requires in the way of transportation,

and the rates for the service of said Southern Pacific Company are not satisfactory; and Whereas, A. Welch and his associates will either see a corporation which already exists for the purpose of constructing and operating said railroad, or will organize a new corporation for the purpose of constructing and operating said railroad; and Whereas, the undersigned, hereby agree to and subscribe for the number of shares of stock placed opposite our respective names, in a corporation which already exists or may be hereafter formed for the purpose of constructing and operating said railroad; and Whereas, said subscriptions shall be on the basis that the par value of each share of stock shall be one hundred dollars (\$100), said stock to be non-assessable.

This subscription is made upon the express condition that said railroad shall be completed between Eugene and Portland, so as to make a continuous railroad in competition with the said Southern Pacific railroad, within eighteen (18) months from the first day of September, 1917, and shall be equipped for and shall carry passengers and freight and is made on the further condition that said railroad shall not at any time be transferred or sold to, or controlled by the said Southern Pacific Company, or to any person or persons who are in any way connected with said Southern Pacific Company, nor shall any stock in said railroad be sold to said Southern Pacific Company. It being expressly understood that the principal object of this subscription is for the purpose of securing an independent and competing line of railroad between Eugene and Portland, Oregon. This subscription is made on the further condition that said railroad shall extend from Eugene on the west side of the Willamette river as far north as Junction City, before the same crosses the Willamette river. But said road may be constructed across the Willamette river at any point that may be selected, so that the same crosses the Willamette river north of Junction City Oregon.

### COMMISSION ACTS FOR THE LUMBERMEN

Salem, Or., Sept. 12.—The railway commission yesterday sent a letter to the railway commissions of Nebraska, North Dakota, South Dakota, Montana, Wyoming and Kansas, asking for their co-operation against the proposed increase in rates on lumber from Oregon and Washington to Eastern ports. This is in performance of the promise of the commission made at the meeting with the representatives of the Oregon and Washington Lumber Associations in Portland last Monday.

The letters are alike in character, giving the reasons urged against the proposed increase in almost the same words as in the lumbermen's petition presented Monday. The text of the telegram sent from Portland to the interstate commerce commission at Washington, D. C., at that time is given, and the other commissions are urged to send telegrams of like character.
