OWNERSHIP FORCES
START CAMPAIGN**

MEETING HELD LAST NIGHT AND
PLAN OF CAMPAIGN OUTLINED
BUT NOT YET PERFECTED.
WELL ORGANIZED AND HOPE
TO CARRY WATERWORKS
BOND ELECTION.

A meeting of municipal ownership advocates was held in Frank's hall last night to arrange the preliminary details for the beginning of the campaign to be waged between now and
