CREDIT FOR DEBATING SOCIETY WORK

STUDENTS OF UNIVERSITY PETITION FACULTY—SOPHOMORE CLASS EJECTS OFFICERS

A petition has been presented to the University faculty to grant members of the debating societies, who take up active work, college credit for their efforts. The petition requests that one semester credit be given for a year's work. At the present time a credit and a half is granted to members of the debating teams. Over 120 semester credits are required for graduation. The petitioners want the credit for those who cannot make the teams, in order to strengthen the society work. The faculty is likely to look favorably upon the movement.

President Campbell, when new buildings are erected, expects to arrange so that each society will have its own hall, used for no other purpose but meetings of its members. Each organization will then probably furnish its own hall, making it almost a club.
