Minneapolis, Oct. 8.—As a result of its investigation of the so-called "Little Black Book" the federal grand jury today returned 19 indictments against a well-known man and the officers of the Northwestern Lumbermen's Association, charging conspiracy to defraud in the use of the book.

The black book plan was pursued by lumbermen and other opponents of the mail order houses and provided simply that victims of the device were to be made to answer futile correspondence and send out innumerable catalogues, all with no result in trade.
