BIG INCREASE IN VALUE OF EUGENE PROPERTY

ASSESSOR FIXES VALUES THIS YEAR OVER \$126,000 GREATER THAN LAST

INCREASE DUE TO EXTENSIVE IMPROVEMENTS AND INFLUX OF POPULATION—MORE THAN MILLION AND A HALF INCREASE OVER 1905

The assessed valuation of property in Eugene for 1907 shows a considerable increase over that of the previous year, County Clerk Lee and assistants having just completed the footings for Eugene city and Eugene school district, as well as Springfield city and Springfield school district. The total assessed valuation of property in the city of Eugene, as fixed by Assessor Keeney this year, is \$3,513,487, which is an increase of \$126,377 over 1906 and an increase of \$1,659,792 over 1905. The valuation in the school district, which is No. 4, this year is \$3,728,985, an increase over 1906 of \$123,795, and over 1905 of \$1,764,340.

The 1907 assessed valuation in Springfield city is \$246,450, and of the school district, which is No. 19, \$523,270. In 1906 it was as follows: City, \$231,430; school district, \$447,055. In 1905 as follows: City, \$111,210; school district, \$217,260.

The reason for the big increase made in 1906 over the previous year was the policy inaugurated by Assessor Keeney to assess all property as near its real value as possible, instead of about one-half its value, which had been the custom before. The increase this year over 1906 is due to the extensive improvements in the city and the increase in population.

The totals for other municipalities and school districts in the county have not yet been footed up but the work will be completed soon.

"SUPREME ENERGY" BISHOP BELL'S SUBJECT

A very appreciative audience listened to Bishop Bell last evening at the United Brethren church. His subject was "Supreme Energy," talking for his text "Put on thy strength."
