JAN KUBELIK, GREAT VIOLINIST, AT CLOSE RANGE

Jan Kubelik, the great Bohemian violinist, who comes to the Eugene theatre Friday, January 10th, is perhaps the most remarkable musician before the public today. During his former visits to America much comment was elicited in newspaper fields by the apparent dilapidation of Kubelik to be interviewed. During his concerts he refused absolutely to see any one. After a number he retired to his dressing room to remain there until summoned for his next appearance. The reason for this is that during a concert Kubelik practices constantly. After the first number has been rendered by him, he retires to spend his time in practicing until the next call comes. It looks easy to the uninitiated, this playing of a few numbers at an immense return, but the work itself is almost as tremendous as the task of playing in the masterly manner that Kubelik alone knows.

It is this characteristic of the great violinist that explains, perhaps, his attitude in Chicago at his last concert, when he was presented with a huge bouquet of roses, which some admirer threw upon the stage at the close of a selection. Kubelik picked them up absent-mindedly, bowed in a matter-of-fact way, and made his exit, carrying the flowers stem up. It was not until he reached his dressing room that his attendant called his attention to the fact that such was the case. So entrapt was Kubelik in his work that he failed to realize what he had been doing until the spell of his own music had worn itself away.

Mrs. Kubelik accompanies her husband on the present tour, and attends every concert, occupying a stage box, where she can watch him from beginning to end of the performance. She is one of the most devoted of wives, as he is one of the most devoted of husbands. Seeing that he does not catch cold, and that no injury comes to his hands, which have been insured for \$85,000, demands most of Mrs. Kubelik's time. When at a concert she is attended by an East Indian servant, in oriental costume, who guards the entrance to the box.
