EUGENE HIGH LOSES ONE AND WINS ANOTHER

The Eugene ladies last night lost to the Salem maids by the score of 26 to 7, but the boys of the local high school turned around and won by the score of 37 to 14 from the Salem aggregation, winning first place in the league.

The appearance of girls in basketball will not be made any more in Eugene; the board of directors of the school district prohibiting it on the advice of Professor Carson, of the University. The Eugene girls, nevertheless, wanted to win last night and played pluckily against their larger and more active opponents, and for some time held the score down. The score at the end of the first half was 13 to 9.

The Salem boys' team was weakened by the illness of three of its regular players, but even with them it is doubtful if they could stand before the swift local aggregation. Eugene started the basket tossing after five minutes of play, Salem having missed several open shots. Then followed a perfect fusillade of baskets during the middle of the half, Salem doing some clever blocking in the latter part of the half. The score at the end of the half stood 19 to 2.

In the second half of the game the same tact worked on the part of the local lads followed as before. There was nothing sensational, only steady, clever passing, coupled with fair accuracy.

Glyn and Clay Watson, the local forwards, played together very well, and did some pretty throwing. While the older brother, Glyn, is really the better man, the younger, age and size considered, is perhaps the coolest player ever seen here.

Mitchell did well at centre, but is too rough. In another year he will be a hard man to beat. Cockerline and Bean, the guards, played their usual aggressive game, coupled with cool, calculating decision.

Eugene now leads the Western Oregon Intercollegiate league, the only team she has not met being Roseburg. Roseburg is second, Salem third and Albany last.
