## A THOUSAND TREES ORDERED FOR FAIRMOUNT

ORDER PLACED WITH OREGON NURSERY COMPANY, OF SALEM, BY IMPROVEMENT CLUB

RESOLUTIONS ADOPTED ASKING THAT NEW SCHOOL BUILDING BE ERECTED ON DISTRICT'S LOT IN FAIRMOUNT—COMMITTEE TO INTERVIEW SCHOOL BOARD

A special meeting of the East Eugene Improvement Club was held last night, at which time the matter of locating the proposed new public school building on the district's lot in Fairmount was taken up. At a previous meeting of the club a committee consisting of W. H. Dempster, M. Svarverud and Ed Judkins was appointed to draft resolutions on this matter and the following was presented last night and adopted by the club:

"We, your committee, would respectfully report as follows: Since public expression has been given in the press of the city to the effect that the school board must erect a new school building this year and since it was stated in the same item that the board probably would not think it best to erect the building in East Eugene on the lot owned by the district, therefore we would urge the appointment of a committee of three persons who shall collectively call upon the members of the school board and ascertain their views on this important matter and carefully and exactly report their sentiments to this club."

The committee as recommended in the resolutions was appointed and consists of the following: J. O. Bristol, T. H. Garrett and M. Svarverud.

**A Thousand Trees Ordered.**  
The matter of selecting the kinds of trees for the various streets in Fairmount was taken up, the decision being as follows: On Columbia avenue, Linden trees; on Moss avenue and Orchard avenue, horse chestnut; on Villard avenue and Fairmount boulevard, maple trees, and on Walnut avenue, walnut trees. An order for 1000 trees was placed with the Oregon Nursery Company at Salem, and they will arrive within a few days. The work of setting them out will begin immediately upon their arrival.
