# CONTRACT FOR HULIN BUILDING HAS BEEN LET

W. B. MUMMEY LOWEST BIDDER ON NEW TWO-STORY BRICK ON EAST NINTH STREET—WILL BE ERECTED AT ONCE—WILL HAVE PRESSED BRICK FRONT WITH STONE TRIMMINGS

L. G. Hulin today let the contract for the erection of his two-story brick business block on East Ninth street to W. B. Mumme. The contract price is not given out for publication. The materials for the construction of the building are all ready and it will be rushed to completion. The stone for the foundation, the con-

tract for the building of which has been let to C. McAlpin, is being delivered and the other materials will be on the ground within a few days. The building will be 20x60 feet in dimensions and will be very handsome and ornamental. It will have a pressed brick front with stone trimmings and big plate glass windows. The upper floor of the building will be divided into six lodging rooms which have already been leased to the Hoffman House to be used as an annex. The store room on the lower floor has been spoken for by a local business firm which will move there from its present location. There will be a six-foot basement. This building will be one of the handsomest in the city when completed and will be an ornament to that portion of the business section. John Hunziker, the architect, drew the plans for the structure.

## FRANCHISE FOR LIGHT PLANT AT CRESWELL

COUNTY COURT GRANTS JOHN TUNELL RIGHT TO ERECT POLES IN STREETS AND COUNTY ROADS

Upon petition of many residents of Creswell, the county court today granted John Tunell, owner of the flour mill at that place, a 20-year franchise to erect and maintain poles and wires in the streets of Creswell and the county road surrounding for an electric light plant which is now being installed at the mill and will be operated by steam.

The franchise allows the erection of poles and wires on the following county roads: Nos. 269, 225, 294, 255, 292, 384, 469, 382 and 279; and the following streets in the unincorporated town of Creswell: A, B, C, D, Avenue First, Second, Third, Fourth and Fifth. It is provided in the order granting the franchise that if work on the plant is not begun and a reasonable amount completed within six months of the date of the granting of the franchise, it shall be revoked.
