N. A. W. HOWE BEQUEATHS \$2000 TO METHODIST CHURCH AT CRESWELL AND \$200 EACH TO MISSIONARY AND CHURCH EXTENSION SOCIETIES.

The will of Norman A. W. Howe, the pioneer who died at his home at Creswell on January 25, was admitted to probate late yesterday afternoon.

The will, which was executed on April 6, 1895, provides as follows: After funeral expenses and debts are paid, the sum of \$200 is bequeathed to the church extension society of the Methodist Episcopal church, and \$200 to the Woman's Home Missionary Society of the church, to be used on the Pacific coast.
