YOUNG MAN ARRESTED FOR HORSE STEALING

ELLIS WILHELM IN COUNTY JAIL Awaiting Arrival of Deputy Sheriff from Lakeview—Arrested One Day Last Week

(Special Correspondence.) Lowell, Feb. 10.—The community of Lowell was somewhat surprised the 7th inst. by the sheriff arresting Ellis Wilhelm, of Hazel Dell, son of David Wilhelm, for horse stealing. The boy is about sixteen years old and last fall his father gave him the privilege of earning a few dimes for himself and he went across the mountains to Eastern Oregon by the way of Odell Lake, following the trail that the railroad surveyors had blazed out, and finding employment in the country northeast of the lakes herding sheep for a short time. When he returned home late in the fall he brought a horse he claimed to have bought. Soon after his return there was a rumor circulated, caused by an item published in the Silver Lake paper that the boy had stolen the horse and left for the Willamette valley, but nothing more was heard of the affair and it was the impression of the neighborhood that it was a mistake until the arrest was made. He traded the horse off a short time ago, but the horse is in the vicinity of Dexter and will be easily found. David Wilhelm, his father, is known to be a man of good standing and highly respected by all who know him, and is no doubt very much grieved over his son's actions. (Harry Graham, acting as special deputy sheriff, made the arrest, and the young man is now in the county jail. A deputy sheriff from Lakeview is expected here tonight to take him back there.—Editor.)
