CORONER'S JURY AGAINST POLICEMAN

Portland, March 3.—The coroner's jury which held an inquest over the body of Henry Shafer, the longshoreman, shot to death last night by Patrolman N. H. Suttler, tonight found that Shafer came to his death by shooting in the hands of Patrolman Suttler and found the shooting not justifiable. Immediately after the verdict was returned District Attorney John Manning ordered Suttler under arrest, and stated that tomorrow, sitting as a grand jury, he would indict the policeman for murder in the second degree. Suttler was the target for opprobrious epithets and came near personal insult from Shafer's friends as he was being led from the hearing. The courtroom was filled with spectators of the workman colony which populates the neighborhood in which the shooting occurred.
