FRANCE FEARS SERIOUS TROUBLE WITH HAYTIANS

Paris, March 16.—The situation between the Haytian government and France has become acute and critical. The French legation at Port au Prince is menaced and a general massacre of white residents at the island is feared. This information was conveyed in an official dispatch to the foreign office from M. Carteron, French minister to Hayti.

Cruisers Bound for Scene.
London, March 16.—Two British cruisers have been ordered to Hayti to protect British interests.

Berlin, March 16.—A German cruiser has been ordered to Hayti to protect German subjects and other foreigners.

Paris, March 16.—Owing to the unrest in Hayti a French cruiser has been despatched to Port au Prince.
