## RAILROAD SELLS REMAINDER OF GRANT

The following dispatch appeared in the Oregonian today from its Washington correspondent:

Washington, March 18.—It is believed in government circles that a secret contract has been made by the Oregon & California Railroad Company, under which it has agreed to sell the remaining 2,000,000 acres of its grant to one single purchaser, and that a large sum of money has been paid to the railroad company on account by the purchaser. The attention of a representative of the Booth-Kelly Company, who has been contending for the innocent-purchaser amendment to the Fulton resolution, was today called to this report, and he remarked: "Then whoever has purchased this land ought to be protected like the rest of us," merely showing that the lumber companies would be willing that the government should make any sacrifice in order to give them a sound title where they now hold a shaky one. This incident will be related to the public lands committee tomorrow.

The lumbermen left for home today, pretty well disheartened. They were confident when they came here that they would have an easy fight, but developments before the committee were somewhat surprising to them, and privately they admit that they are defeated. Nevertheless it is expected that an attempt will be made when the resolution goes into the house to secure the adoption of the innocent purchasers' amendment if the committee reports the resolution as it passed the senate.
