LA PROSPERIDAD COLONY ASSOCIATION

James Watson, of Los Angeles, special agent and lecturer for the La Prosperidad Co-operative Colony Association, of Los Angeles, arrived in Eugene today to lecture on the plan of the new association.

The Prosperidad Colony Association is already meeting with the most phenomenal success, although only five months old, \$35,000 worth of stock being sold last month. It has now members in every state of the Union, Canada, Alaska and Europe, the sound business principles, together with equality, justice and honesty of the plan having commanded general admiration and confidence.

The association intends to colonize a tract of 500,000 acres of rich virgin, fertile soil of volcanic ash, located in the peninsula of Lower California, a concession from the Mexican government having been already obtained, together with valuable harbors, fishing, mineral, educational and other rights, exemptions from duty and taxes for 10 years.

The climate is the most ideal and perfect on the globe, which is claiming much, but which is proven by facts and figures. Surrounded by mountains on three sides, some snow capped, open to the beautiful Pacific 15 miles distant, all the fruits of the semi-tropics are grown with great success. 
