GERMAN KAISER TAFFIES BRITISH WARSHIP OFFICERS

Berlin, April 14.—A dispatch from Corfu states that Emperor William in course of a dinner in honor of the officers of the British battleship Implacable, following a toast, said:

"I drink to our two flags, and I wish that they may ever be united for their own welfare and the world's peace."

Captain Kerr, commander of the Implacable, whose father was Lord Admiral Kerr, responded: "My father used to say with reference to your majesty that God had created a great superior officer of a man who had become a great admiral."

COUNT MURDERED BY YOUNG STUDENT

Vienna, April 14.—The whole of Galicia is in a state of excitement over the assassination at Lemberg on Sunday of Count Andre Potocki, governor of that province, by a Ruthenian student while the count was giving an audience to a delegation of students.

The "Young Ruthenians" in the Austrian parliament declare such crimes a necessity to put a stop to Polish oppression, and last night a thousand Poles participated in an anti-Ruthenian demonstration. They gathered in mobs and broke the windows of the Ruthenian clubs of the city.

S. H. FRIENDLY MAY BUILD ANOTHER STORY

S. H. Friendly, the pioneer dry goods merchant, is having plans drawn for a second story to the building occupied by the ladies' department of his store. with military honors. Later in the afternoon the admiral returned the visit and paid his respects to the governor at the Hotel Del Coronado.

Following these ceremonies, a large reception committee, headed by U. S. Grant, Jr., visited the Commodore and were received by Admiral Thomas, as were the chairmen of the various sub-committees in charge of the fleet celebration. Later in the day several boats were sent out from the shore with 35,000 California oranges, to be distributed among the enlisted men.
