SPRINGFIELD HAPPENINGS OF PAST WEEK

The new foundry proposition was brought up at the Commercial Club (Friday night) and thoroughly discussed. One of the gentlemen who is interested in the establishment of the foundry at this place was present and laid his plans before the club and the citizens of Springfield, convincing them that he meant business. They propose establishing a complete foundry, one that will be able to take care of any and all the work that is to be done in this locality, and anticipate erecting a building to cover a ground space of 55x120 feet. In their proposal to the citizens, they ask that a free site be given them and the lumber put on the ground for the building. While the request means that should the Commercial Club accept the proposition a considerable amount of money must necessarily be raised, yet it is a good proposition and should be accepted if possible. A committee of three was appointed by the club to take further investigations regarding the site, lumber and raising of the necessary amount of money, and the committee will make a report of their progress at the next regular meeting.

Good Baseball Team.
Springfield, as usual, will have a good ball team again this season. The fans were around with a subscription paper Tuesday for the purpose of raising money to put the grounds in shape. Several of the old players that were with the team last season will be seen on the diamond with the locals, and there will also be some new faces who have showed up well and will likely make the team. It is reported that the old reliable twirler, Charles Talafiero, will return to Springfield in the near future and will perhaps be induced to sign up with the team.

New Electric Plant.
The News learns from a reliable source that the machinery, including the large dynamo at the Portland plant, have been sold to a Portland firm, and that it will be replaced by new machinery of a more up to date kind and greater capacity. The change has been made owing to the inadequacy of the present power. At present the power furnished has been overloaded and the light service has been very poor, and with the addition of the car service it would be impossible to furnish the necessary amount of current, thus the change.
