CLEARING SITE FOR FIVE-STORY BRICK BLOCK

OLD FRAME BUILDING AT EAST NINTH AND OAK STREETS BEING TAKEN AWAY—PART OF IT WILL BE TORN DOWN AND OTHER PART MOVED TO HALL'S WAREHOUSE

Geo. T. Hall, Sr., this morning began tearing out the front of the old frame buildings on the site of the Old Fellows' new five-story brick building at the corner of East Ninth and Oak streets, preparatory to moving it away. A portion of the building will be torn down and the remainder moved to a lot adjoining Mr. Hall's warehouse, the present storage capacity being limited. Poyner & Hunt have the contract to move the building.

The occupants of the old building have all moved out. Mrs. Fox, the milliner, being the latest. She moved her stock of goods out this morning and will be located in the racket store two doors west until a more suitable location can be found. Condon's bakery moved yesterday, and is now located in the new Hullin block further west on the same street. Hamilton & Van Oudstrand's grocery was moved last week to the new Barnard building at the corner of West Eighth and Charnelton streets.

Just as soon as the old building is off the ground Carson Mathews will begin the work of excavating for the new block and it is expected that brick work will begin about the middle of May, or possibly before.
