SEATTLE WINS

IN PORTLAND

ATHLETIC CONTEST

Portland, April 25.—Representatives of the Seattle Amateur Athletic Club came out with flying colors in the three days' wrestling and boxing tournament for the championships of the Pacific coast which concluded here tonight. Of its entries only one, William Speck, in the 125-pound boxing class, failed to take first place. The bouts throughout were interesting, and though some of the contestants were unevenly matched, most of the antagonists who faced each other showed practically equal ability. This was notably especially in the 125-pound wrestling event tonight, which went to V. Venable of Seattle over F. A. Brownell of the Reliance Club, of San Francisco. Venable threw his opponent after eleven minutes and thirty-five seconds of the hardest amateur wrestling ever seen in this city. As it is his victory is not clear of question. After the men had been at it for about eight minutes Brownell managed to get Venable's shoulders so close to the mat that the spectators who were closest to the wrestlers were confident that Brownell had secured a fall. The total championships are as follows: Seattle, 7; Mulnomah, 3; Spokane, 1; Olympic, 1.

EUGENE FLOUR MILL

COMPLAINS OF RATES

Salem, Or., April 25.—J. M. Shelley, of Eugene, manager of the Eugene Mill & Elevator Company, has protested to the state railroad commission against a recent raise of nearly 100 per cent in certain local freight rates in that part of the state. He encloses a shipping receipt showing that he pays a rate of 23 cents per 100 pounds on wheat and oats from Eugene to Yoncalla, 44 miles, which rate, he says, is excessive, unjust and unreasonable. Prior to January 1, 1907, the rate was 14 cents. The rate for a little longer distance, as, for instance, from Eugene to Roseburg, is now 31 cents, whereas the former rate was 15 cents. This is an increase of over 100 per cent. The railroad commission will investigate.
