SETTLER'S HOME IS BLOWN TO ATOMS

Wardner, Idaho, April 30.—With their home blown to atoms by the explosion of a large quantity of dynamite, themselves cut in many places and badly stunned by the shock, and their hired man blown many feet from the house by the powder and badly injured, E. A. Carlson and wife have reached Kingstons, eight miles below Wardner, after a hard journey down the river.

They relate a harrowing story of their nearness to death at the hands of would-be assassins. The Carlsons reside on a ranch up the North Fork river and had just completed a large new house on their ranch. Last evening, just after retiring, a terrific explosion of dynamite took place, completely demolishing the house and furniture, and throwing the inmates many feet through the air, injuring and stunning them.

PUBLISHERS GATHER EVIDENCE AGAINST TRUST

Washington, April 30.—A mass of data bearing on what he charged to be a combination of papermakers to raise prices, and restrict production was furnished today by John Norris, representing the American Newspaper Publishers' Association, to the select committee of the house which is conducting an investigation into the subject of the price of news print paper in the United States.

During the time Mr. Norris was ex-cused General Felix Agnus, of the Baltimore American, testified regarding his various contracts with paper manufacturers, and said that on January 1 last he was forced by the International Paper Company to pay \$12 per ton more for paper than he did last year.

At the close of today's session Chairman Mann stated that apparently some of the publishers were not as anxious to attend the hearing as they originally appeared to be, but said that he would force their presence and secure their testimony.

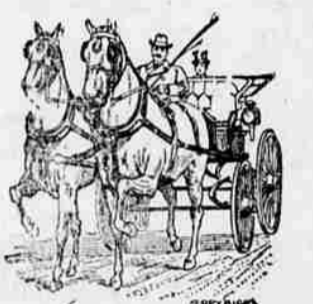
