BUILDING PERMITS FOR MONTH OF APRIL OVER \$83,000

FIGURES FURNISHED BY BUILDING INSPECTOR McFARLAND FOR FIRST MONTH UNDER NEW CITY LAW—REPAIRS AGGREGATE SEVERAL HUNDRED DOLLARS MORE

Under the new city building ordinance all those contemplating erecting new buildings and those who desire to make repairs to old buildings to the value of \$30 and over within the city limits are required to take out a permit from Building Inspector V. McFarland.

The total value of the above is \$83,800. It is probable that the minor repairs will aggregate nearly \$2000, making the total for the month \$85,800 of more. Nearly all of the buildings for which permits were granted in April are now in course of erection, and there are two or three times that many that were started before April and are now building.

HOMING PIGEONS MAKE GOOD TIME FROM EUGENE

Two of J. P. Linsartek's homing pigeons won first and third prize and two of H. B. Baxer's racing birds captured second and fourth places in the pigeon race from Eugene to Portland yesterday afternoon, the first official race of a series of five to be held this summer for old birds.

The distance from Eugene to the loft in Portland was covered in two hours and 59 1-2 minutes, being practically a mile in one and three-quarters minutes. Sixty odd birds took part in the flight from the college town and the time is fairly good in view of the heavy rain that prevailed during parts of the flight.

SENSATIONAL GOLD STRIKE NEAR GRANTS PASS

Grants Pass, May 4.—A sensational gold strike has just been made on Williams creek, about 22 miles from Grants Pass, by the Jones brothers and the Harrison brothers. From the accounts brought in it seems to be in the nature of a pocket, \$7000 having already been taken out, with an immense amount in sight. The finders brought some of the gold in the last of the week and purchased rifles to take out with them to guard their find. There is a possibility that it may be on some of the Southern Pacific railroad land. Some of the flakes of gold were half the size of a man's palm. A small rush of prospectors is on to the vicinity. Many other rich finds have been made in this same district.

PROCLAMATION

Whereas, there was submitted to the people of the city of Eugene, Oregon, at a special election for that purpose on the 18th day of April, 1908, an initiative proposal for being ordained by the Common Council, pursuant to and in accordance with the general laws of the state of Oregon, for amending sections 108 and 112 of the charter of said city, and whereas there was at the same manner submitted to the people of said city for their approval or rejection an initiative proposal to amend the charter of said city by adding a section thereto forbidding the establishment of cemeteries or additions thereto within the city, or the burial of human bodies therein, except under certain conditions, and Whereas, the votes cast at said election having been this 20th day of April, 1908, duly canvassed and determined and the said amendment of said sections 108 and 112 as aforesaid having carried by an affirmative vote of 687 as against 171 negative votes thereon. Now, therefore, I, J. D. Matlock, mayor of said city of Eugene, by virtue of the authority vested in me as mayor, do hereby proclaim, announce and declare that the whole number of votes cast for and against said proposed amendments are as stated above, and that said amendments received an affirmative majority of all votes cast and that said proposed amendments, from the date hereof, be and the same are in full force and effect as a law of the city of Eugene, and a part of the charter of said city.

That said proposed amendment of the charter by adding an additional section thereto forbidding the establishment of cemeteries or additions thereto failed to receive a majority of the votes cast thereon and thereby failed to become a law of said city or a part of the charter thereof. In witness whereof, I have hereunto set my hand this 20th day of April, 1908, and caused the seal of said city to be hereunto affixed. J. D. MATLOCK, Mayor of the City of Eugene. Attest: B. F.
