WIDOWS OF VETERANS GET BETTER PENSIONS

Only widows of the Civil War soldiers who married previous to June 30, 1890, are entitled to a pension with increase as provided by the new law which went into effect on the 1st of last month.

Charles Bent, United States pension agent at Chicago, in an interview in the Tribune, says: "Under the new law the pension of all widows, minors and helpless children now on the rolls at a less rate is increased to \$12 per month, and they will be paid at the increased rate at the next quarterly payment on July 4th."

These not already on the rolls who are pensionable under the new law should make their application direct to the commissioner of pensions at Washington, D. C."
