PORTLAND MARKET REPORT

The urgent message sent out by the American Woolen Company to the wool growers of the West came some time ago asking them to abandon the use of algal twine in the tying of fleeces is having some effect.

The latest statements issued by the American Woolen Company regarding the use of the algal twine, indicate that something has been accomplished in the reform desired, but that further efforts are needed in order to put a stop to the old practice altogether.
