Clark, Justice of the Peace in and for Creswell Precinct, Lane County, Oregon, that at the said election the total number of votes cast in the precinct of Zumwalt, in Lane county, Oregon, on the question, "For and Against stock running at large," is and was 92 votes, and the said number of votes cast in the said Zumwalt precinct "Against stock running at large" is and was 54 votes.

Therefore, in compliance with Section 4245 of the General Laws of Oregon, passed by the legislature of the state of Oregon in the year 1907, notice is hereby given that after 60 days from the date of this notice it will be unlawful for stock to run at large in said Zumwalt precinct, Lane County, Oregon, under penalty of \$10 for the first offence and \$20 for each and every subsequent offence, to be recovered from the owner of the stock in civil action in the name of the State of Oregon before a Justice of the peace of the precinct in which such owner or keeper, or either of them, may reside, and such penalty shall be for the benefit of, and when collected paid into, the common school fund of the county in which such action is brought within sixty days after such animal is proved to be at large.
