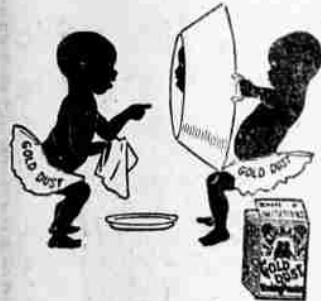

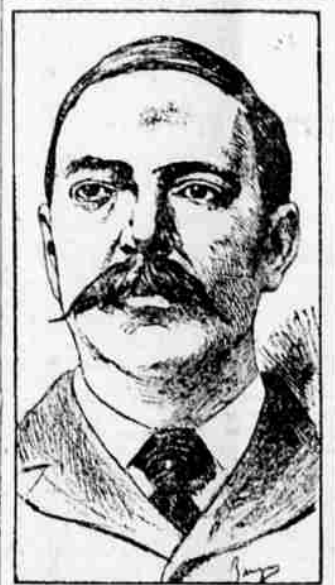

presenting the name of Curtis Guild, Massachusetts, as candidate for vice-president.

"In behalf of Massachusetts, I have the honor to present to this convention the governor of that state for nomination, as your candidate for vice-president. Born in Massachusetts, the descendant of Massachusetts ancestors, with the blood of the revolutionary soldiers in his veins, he was bred in her schools and graduated with honors from Harvard, her great university, equal with the state itself. By inheritance and conviction alike, he was republican and as soon as he was out of college, he began to work for the party, and to do all in his power to promote its success and advance its principles. In the campaign of 1884, when there was widespread revolt against the republican candidate, he stood firm for his party, and cheerfully encountered abuse and obloquy because he would not desert the cause to which he was devoted.

"For years he served his party, putting at their disposal all his powers of eloquent speech in any state at any time. All this he did without thought of office or reward.

"When the war with Spain broke upon the country, he was first to offer his services and gave up his commission as general of the militia, to take the position of adjutant in a regiment ordered to the front. Appointed later to the staff of General Lee, he served with distinction throughout the war, commended

their public men timely and as they very bravely they have placed Governor Guild.

"I nominate him and I trust of Republican victory will reverberate from Idaho to the Everglades; from the Peninsula to the Pecos; from Hill Gate to the Golden Gate.

"He lives for those who love him; for those who love him true; for the heaven that bends above him; and the good that he can do; for the wrongs that need resistance; for the future in the distance; and the good that men can do.

"When Massachusetts was reached, its chairman seconded the nomination of Sherman.

alike by his superior officers and by all with whom he was associated.

In recognition of his services President McKinley offered him a high place in one of our new possessions, which he declined.

"He continued with unabated zeal to work for the republican party, and in 1900 he accompanied President Roosevelt in his great campaign of that year, speaking with him in every part of the country.

"Six years ago he was nominated for lieutenant-governor of Massachusetts. Three times elected to that office, he was promoted to the governorship and three times elected by decisive majorities and is now serving his last term.

"Such is the record of the man I present to this convention. In the name of Massachusetts, for nomination as vice-president. It is a record of distinguished service to the party and the state, generously, ungrudgingly given. He has been an able and honorable governor, devoting all his strength of body and mind to the advancement of Massachusetts, Liberal and progressive, his name is associated not only with sound administration, but with the earnest advocacy of measures which would promote the welfare of the state, and which were in the interests of the broadest humanity. Of conspicuous ability, of remarkable eloquence in speech, of unblemished character, a life long and loyal republican, he would bring to the service of the nation the same earnest faith in what he believes to be right, that he has for four years given to Massachusetts and to the service of his party.

"I have the honor, the great honor, to present to you for nomination, the Hon. Curtis Guild for Guild was made by Chas. E. Osborne, Mich., whose address follows:

"From his state he had fought diseases in school and factory; he has done away with child labor at night and will abolish child labor altogether, if given an opportunity. He has divorced the saloon from politics and the result is a reign of reason, with neither blue laws nor the lid off under his leadership and a banking law under his leadership and a banking law inaugurated so safe that not a failure occurred under it during last year's panic. Railroad and trolley consolidation destroying competition has been opposed by him and the highest courts sustained his position. Governor Guild's political belief contains the high sentiment that race, color nor creed should give a man office or keep him from it.

"He is a brigadier general in the state service; rose from lieutenant to colonel in the Spanish-American war, accomplished civil and sanitary reform in Cuba; broke up the death stalking fever camps in Southern Florida.

"There is no twilight zone in Governor Guild's conscience where duty compromises with policy or right with wrong. He is just and kindly in dealing with labor and has his own support and respect.

"Governor Guild is a powerful and convincing orator and tireless and fearless campaigner. He has transformed Massachusetts from 16,000 Democrats to 100,000 Republicans.

"The Nation needs him; the Republican party must have him; President Taft cannot get along without him; Massachusetts Republicans lift

the chief magistracy should devolve upon him, he is amply fitted by ability and experience to perform them in a manner creditable to the party and to the nation.

"In short, he combines all the elements needed in a successful running mate at this psychological moment.

"Twelve years ago our party went to Chic and New Jersey and chose McKinley and Hobart. We made no mistake then, and we shall make no mistake now, if history repeating itself, we shall again go to Ohio and New Jersey and our ticket shall be Taft and Murphy. I nominate for Vice-President, Ex-Governor Franklin Murphy of New Jersey."

Harry Skinner seconded the nomination of Sherman for North Carolina. Dennis Flynn of Oklahoma spoke from the floor seconding the nomination of Sherman. Tennessee, through H. Clay Evans, and Virginia, through C. B. Slemp, seconded Sherman.

The roll then commenced, some states splitting their votes among the various candidates.

When the issue was announced the big Sherman picture again came to the front and for several minutes the convention was in an uproar.

Sherman Nominated.

The roll call on the first ballot resulted: Sherman 816; Murphy 77; Guild 75; Fairbanks 1; Sheldon 19; absent 1.

Idaho voted six for Sherman; Oregon voted 8 for Sherman; Washington voted 10 for Sherman.

Made It Unanimous.

Senator Crane of Massachusetts moved to make Sherman's nomination unanimous. Governor Fort, New Jersey, seconded and it carried unanimously and Sherman was declared nominated unanimously.

Convention Adjourns.

After some further business an adjournment was had at 11:47 and the convention of 1908 had made its way into the history of the country.

## SHERMAN IS NAMED AS TAFT'S RUNNING MATE

(Continued from Page One.)

the presidency for the term beginning March 4, 1909, the Hon. W. H. Taft of Ohio.

The announcement was greeted with cheering, soon interrupted, however, by a delegate from Michigan who offered a resolution providing that all nominating and seconding speeches of vice presidential candidates be limited to ten minutes. This was carried with a roar and the yell broke into cheer as the first notes of "Marching Through Georgia" were heard from an approaching band.

New Yorkers Enthused.

The New Yorkers, realizing this was the signal for a pre-arranged Sherman demonstration broke into cheers and song. A huge picture of Sherman was carried aloft amid tumultuous cheers. When the Sherman paraders had finished their march it was announced that a meeting of the national committee, would be held, after adjournment of the convention. The call of the roll for nominations then commenced. When Delaware was reached Senator Dupont rose and declared that "Delaware yields to New York." This was the beginning of the Sherman wave and there was an outburst of cheering led by the New York delegation. Timothy L. Woodruff was greeted with great applause as he ascended the platform to nominate Sherman.

The point was made by Woodruff that no republican ticket was ever betrayed when New York was on it, except once, when the "opposing party was bright enough to put New York at the head of their file." This provoked laughter and applause.

On behalf of the united delegates of the pivotal state of New York, too, New York goes, so goes the nation, I present to you the name of Congressman James S. Sherman."

Fervent Applauded.

Speaker Cannon encouraged Woodruff on the platform to second the nomination of Sherman and great enthusiasm. Cannon declared the platform adopted true to the hopes, aspirations and principles of the country. Next he paid tribute to Taft and declared:

"I say without mental reservation that William H. Taft is my candidate." Another outburst of applause followed.

Continuing Cannon said:

"If ever the contingency should arise when God forbid that he should appoint the President, there is no man to whom I had rather trust to lead the Nation of this country than I have in Sherman."
