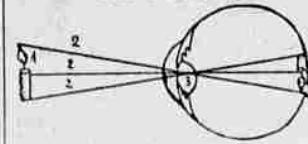
**B. F. YOAKUM, RAILWAY WIZARD.**

### THE EYE AND ITS CARE

(By Dr. Franc Luellie Hard.)  
The Perfect Eye.



1. Object looked at.
2. Rays of light.
3. Crystalline lens.
4. Picture of object on retina.

The perfect or emmetropic eye is an exact sphere about an inch in diameter. In front the cornea is engrafted upon the main ball and is one-sixth of the circumference.

The emmetropic eye is very hard to find, only one person in many having perfect eyes. These see the stars as bright points of light instead of a light with the many spangles that most of us are accustomed to seeing.

When an object is looked at, rays from it enter the eye, focus upon the retina, and from there are carried to the brain through the optic nerve. But in order to get to the retina the rays from the object must first pass through the air, then the cornea, the aqueous humor, the pupil, the crystalline lens, the vitreous humor, and finally to the retina. Then the little fibres of the retina, called the rods and cones, must be set in action to carry the message to the brain, before we realize what the object looked at. This sounds like a long process, but it is all done so quickly that we are not aware of it at all.

When passing through the crystalline lens the rays of light, which enter the eye in a slanting direction, are crossed, so that the picture formed on the retina is reversed. The brain, however, interprets this correctly, and we see the object as it is. If the eye is too long or too short, vision is interfered with, and it becomes necessary to use glasses to bring the rays to a focus upon the retina and thus give the perfect vision.

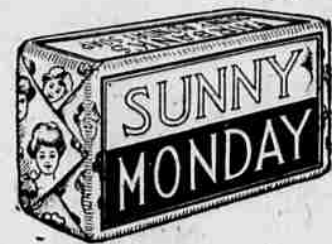

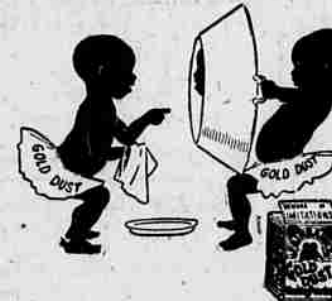
