BOOTH EXPLAINS WHY KRIBS GAVE CHECK FOR \$800

Portland, Or., June 25.—That a check for \$800 given by Frederick A. Krebs to James Booth, ex-convict of the Penitentiary and attorney, was given to the government to take care of a wife for advance information, is explained by the defense attorney for an option obtained by Krebs for Booth.

Such is the defense set up in the case now on trial in the Federal court. Being jointly involved and having received many of the land laws and threatened with prosecution, Krebs has misinterpreted the check for the purpose of simplifying Francis J. Hines with "dopes" such as Hines wanted, and thus Krebs secured his only immunity, but protection. This is a charge made by the defense as explaining why James Booth was indicted 29 months ago by Hines on the sole testimony of Krebs.

The trial of J. H. Booth is now well under way, the jury being completed yesterday and this forenoon being devoted to the opening statements. United States District Attorney John McCourt opened for the prosecution, being followed by Ex-Senator Dan J. Malachuk for the defense. McCourt consumed 30 minutes and Malachuk spoke an hour and fifteen minutes, being interrupted by the noon recess. Malachuk will complete his statement at 2:30.

McCourt read the indictment, charging Booth with accepting a bribe in return for which he supplied Frederick A. Krebs with advance information which enabled Krebs to scrip land before other people. How long Krebs and Booth had an understanding about supplying advance information, the government was not prepared to say, and the government also admitted that an option may be mixed up with the check.

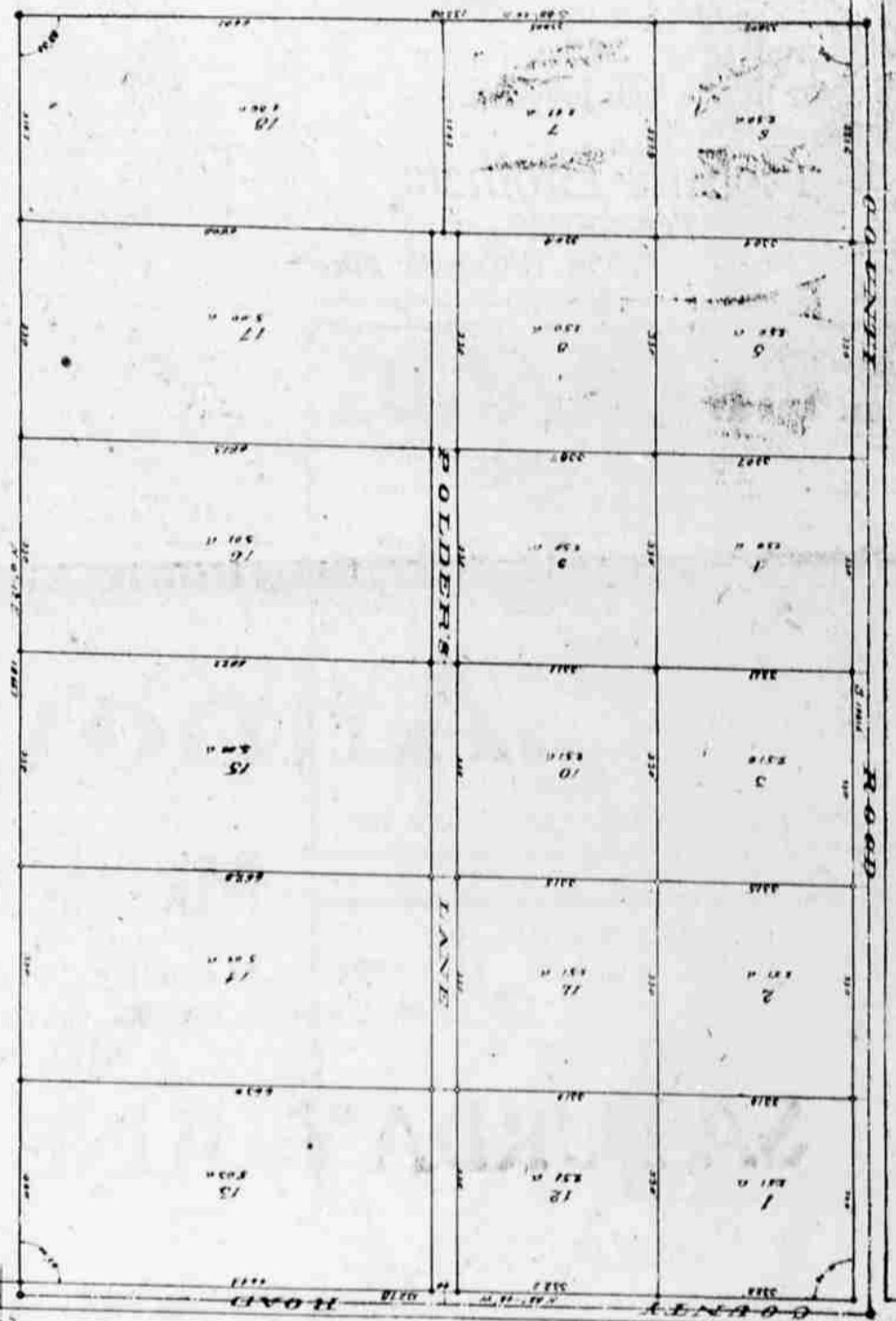
