NORTH YAMHILL STAGE IS ROBBED

North Yamhill, Or., July 2.—Passengers and drivers on the North Yamhill-Tillamook stage were held up by a masked robber at 10:30 o'clock this morning. Frank Perkins the driver, and three passengers were relieved of their valuables at the point of a revolver. When the bandit departed he carried with him the United States government registered mail sack, which the stage was carrying to Tillamook.

The hold-up was pulled off about four miles west of North Yamhill, at the point where the heavily timbered mountainous country, intervening between this city and Tillamook, commences. The amount of money and valuables looted from the passengers and driver is not known.

FORAKER PRAISES AND CRITICISES TAFT.

Cincinnati, O., July 3.—Praise for the personality of William H. Taft, Republican nominee for President, and criticism for him in that he favors the Roosevelt policies, formed a part of the speech delivered yesterday by United States Senator Foraker of the Chamber of Commerce in

When Mr. Foraker referred to Mr. Taft as a "man who in character is all that could be desired," he was interrupted by cheers. When the applause had ceased, he continued:
