LUMBER NOTES FROM THE SIALAW COUNTRY

(Pacific Timber Co.) Sialaw Timber & Boom Company operates a boom on the Sialaw river. This boom now contains about 12,000,000 feet of logs.

Florence Lumber Company, Florence, has not operated its sawmill for three years. Manager William Kyle states that if the proposition to improve the bar is successful he will install a new sawmill plant.

The M. E. Sautbert & Company's plant at Acme has not been operated since last year. Their yard is entirely cleaned up, and no more cutting will be done until the bar is improved. The plant has a capacity of 25,000 feet. T. C. Sautbert has been spending some time in San Francisco.

Manager I. B. Cushman, of the Sialaw Lumber Company, Acme, reports that his mill has been idle since last September, being unable to ship regularly on account of the condition of the bar at the mouth of the Sialaw. This plant is owned by the Wendling Lumber Company, of San Francisco, and has a cutting capacity of 50,000 feet per day. The company has about nine million feet of logs on hand.

Oregon & California Lumber Company, Florence, successors to the Hurd Lumber, Navigation Company, has not operated its mill very steadily since last fall. Some local business has been taken care of. Considerable new equipment is being installed, including a ten-foot band, steam kicker, nigger, transfers, live rolls, conveyors, and pneumatic trimmers. A 600-horsepower twin Corliss engine will also be installed.

The cutting capacity of the sawmills on the Sialaw is approximately a quarter of a million per day. The total shipments from the river for the past five and one-half years aggregated 58,111,885 feet, as follows:
