GOLDSMITH HOME ENTERED BY BURGLARS

IT IS SUPPOSED THAT A QUANTITY OF SILVERWARE WAS TAKEN—GOLDSMITH FAMILY AT NEWPORT—PROBABLY WORK OF TRAMPS.

The residence of Julius Goldsmith on East Eleventh street was entered last night or the night before by a burglar. From an inspection this morning little seemed to be disturbed, unless a quantity of silver plate had been taken. The Goldsmith family has been at Newport for two weeks and as nothing was much disturbed, the only clue that anything had been taken lay in the seeming small quantity of silverware which remained in the drawers of a sideboard.

Entrance to the house was effected either through the front or east side door or a window on the west side of the house opening into the kitchen. Both doors were unlocked, and indications pointed to the fact that a person may have climbed through a window, from finger marks on the sill and dirt on the outside of the house. However, these signs did not appear fresh. That the house-breaking did not occur last night is the theory of Jos. Fellman, of the furniture firm of Campbell-Fellman company, who lives nearby. Thursday night he was followed home from his store, where he was working late. The man who followed him turned off into the Goldsmith yard. Nothing unusual was noticed until this morning, when the two doors were found open by the neighbors.

All the drawers in the dressers, bureaus, etc., in the house, and the furnishings of the rooms were undisturbed. There was no proof that any rummaging had been done. The Goldsmiths are expected home tonight or tomorrow.

Too Many Vags. Acting Chief of Police Purdy lays the blame for the recent frequent house-breakings to tramps and other ill-kept characters who are camping in and near Eugene. During the summer many workmen camp with the regular traveling brake-beam public, and for the officers to distinguish between the two classes is a very hard problem.

For a remedy, work on the streets has been suggested, and partly tried. While occasionally an honest man may be picked up, the example of hard work will clear the town quicker of traveling bad characters than any other plan.

On the vote for the amendment to the charter enabling the council to levy a tax on agricultural land within the city limits stood 111 for and 12 against.—Western Oregon.

MODOC RAILROAD WILL BUILD INTO SOUTHERN OREGON

San Francisco, July 23.—With the filing of articles of incorporation of the Modoc Northern Railway Company the extensive plans for the development of Northeastern California and Southern Oregon were made public. For three years the Southern Pacific Company, through subsidiary corporations, has been building railways in that region and this last corporation is only a part of the system of leased lines which will tap vast areas of the richest land on the Pacific coast.

The Modoc Northern Railway Company has a capital stock of \$2,000,000, divided into shares of the par value of \$100 each. Its directors are E. E. Calvin, William F. Herrin, William Hood, W. R. Scott and J. L. Willcutt. According to the articles of incorporation the Modoc Northern line will be built from Aitonas, Modoc county, in a northwestern direction to a connecting point with the California Northwestern Railway, new being constructed from Weed, on the Southern Pacific road in Siskiyou county, to Klamath Falls, Or. These two lines will meet near Klamath Falls, so the entire length of the Modoc Northern will be about 100 miles. Construction of the line will begin at once and continue until the road is finished. The line will open a virgin country in Southern Oregon connecting Alturas and its vicinity directly with the Southern Pacific and with Oregon.

A railroad official explained that these lines will form a network of railways in the most fertile parts of Oregon and California. Most of the country traversed by them is timbered with white pine, vast forests of great trees covering the land, which is reported by agents of the company to be extraordinarily rich. Many millions of dollars have been invested already in railway building by these companies, and the latest corporation—the Modoc Northern—is now making arrangements to spend nearly \$3,000,000 in construction.

THROUGH STAGE TO KITSON SPRINGS
