### NEW AND MODERN LAUNDRY PLANT TO BE INSTALLED

J. W. BAKER BUYS HALF INTEREST IN FISHER LAUNDRY AND LARGE BUILDING WILL BE ERECTED AT SIXTEENTH AND WILLAMETTE STREETS—PLANT ORDERED FROM SEATTLE

J. W. Baker, of Cottage Grove, has purchased a half interest in the Fisher Laundry in Eugene from E. L. Fisher, and they will erect a larger and a modern plant on property that they have just purchased at the corner of Sixteenth and Willamette streets. The new building will be amply large to accommodate one of the best laundry plants on the coast. Work on the structure will begin in a few days.

Mr. Baker has just returned from Seattle, where he has purchased a complete plant which will be here by the time the new building is completed.

Mr. Baker is not the former state game warden of the same name and initials, but he is the gentleman who until recently controlled the laundry business of Grants Pass and Ashland, in fact, that of nearly all Southern Oregon. He is a thorough laundryman, and as Mr. Fisher also understands his business perhaps as well as any man in the state, the partnership will doubtless be a successful one.

Yesterday President Roosevelt in a statement made it clear that the entire responsibility was his for the issuing of the order discharging the battalion of negro soldiers for participation in the Brownsville, Tex., rioting and the refusal of permission to suspend that order. Representative McDonald, of Multnomah county, will introduce in the next Oregon legislature an anti-cigarette bill, identical with that now in force in the state of Washington.
