BUSY REGULAR SESSION OF CITY COUNCIL

The regular meeting of the city council was held last night, at which time various matters of interest and some that were not of interest, were discussed and acted upon.

The recommendation of the fire and water committee that a new fire plug be located at the corner of West Tenth and Olive streets was accepted and the plug ordered put in.

Mayor Matlock made a statement showing that at the last measurement of the flow of water in Ritchey creek 3,115,000 gallons passed a given point a day.

An ordinance was drawn fixing the grade on the south side of East Eleventh street along the University campus.

The street committee was ordered to investigate the condition of the sidewalks on Olive street from Eighth street to Ninth, and to take such action in the matter as they see fit.

The Warren Construction Company was ordered paid for the work of paving East Eleventh street.

The matter of allowing popcorn vendors to do business on the streets came up and the city attorney was directed to ascertain whether or not they are allowable on the streets.

An ordinance for constructing a sewer in the alley between Fifth and Sixth streets, from Jefferson street to Blair, also one in Twelfth street between Alder and Hilyard; also one on East Thirteenth street a distance of 421 feet near Alder street; also one in the alley between Second and Third streets, commencing on the west side of high street and extending to the river, were passed.

An ordinance prohibiting driving of milk cows to and from pasture but providing that they shall be led through the streets, was passed.

An ordinance providing for a penalty of \$10 for each offense.

Paving Ordinances
The ordinances for paving West Eighth street, from Charnelton to Monroe, was read. It was discussed by members of the council, also by Henry Huddleston and J. M. Shelley, heavy property owners along the street, Huddleston opposing the improvement and Shelley favoring it. An ordinance establishing the property line from the south side of West Eighth street from Charnelton to Lincoln was also read. Both ordinances were laid over until the next meeting.

Petitions
A petition to lay a water pipe on Ferry street from Thirteenth to Seventeenth was referred to the fire and water committee.

A petition from the Hovey heirs to move the frame building now occupied by Seibert & Dodge at the corner of West Eighth and Olive streets to the lot just west of its present location was granted. A two-story brick building will be erected on the corner this fall.

A petition to extend the water mains to College Hill was laid on the table.

A motion to extend the sewer on Eleventh street to Jefferson was granted.

A petition to extend a sewer in the south part of the city was granted.

A protest by S. P. Ness on the curbing in front of his residence property on Olive street was referred to the city engineer. The engineer was ordered to see that the paving company put in a new curb according to grade on the west side of Olive street between Ninth and Tenth.

The city engineer was authorized to employ a man to look after details in the street improvement work, subject to the approval of the street committee.

The city attorney was instructed to file for record the three water rights the city had made for its gravity system on Ritchey creek, and other streams to supplement its flow, and to take such other action as he deems necessary to secure the rights.

The meeting adjourned until Thursday evening.
