land, and Ernest Bolter, of San Francisco.
Other Wrecks Recalled.
Last night is not the first time a lazy bull has wrecked a Southern Pacific train, although this is the worst accident on that account yet recorded. George Bolter, while a fireman under Engineer Emmett Butler, was on a locomotive that was derailed by striking a bull near Woodville, Jackson county, a few years ago. The locomotive jolted along on the ties for a distance of 1100 feet, but fortunately did not fall over. In 1899 a bull derailed and wrecked a locomotive near Halsey, Linn county, killing Fireman Hanson and badly injuring Engineer McFadden. After a layoff of several months McFadden recovered and resumed work just in time to get killed in the Lake Labish horror.

Somersault Explanation
The locomotive did not turn a somersault in any sense, according to railroad men, who state that on level ground an engine never does. While No. 2203 was turned completely around from the direction in which it was running, the fact is explained by the front of the engine being thrown in the air by the body of the animal and the sudden application of the emergency brakes, resulting in the front trucks being hurled off to the right side of the track. The cars behind the engine caught the rear end and shoved it along much faster than the front end was moving until the cab of the light machine was turned in the opposite direction from where it was when on the rails.
