COURSE OF STUDY FOR EUGENE HIGH SCHOOL

LIST OF STUDIES REQUIRED OF STUDENTS IN EACH OF FOUR CLASSES—PEDAGOGY ADDED TO LIST FOR JUNIORS AND SENIORS BUT IT IS OPTIONAL WITH THE STUDENT.

The Eugene high school course of study for the coming school year has been prepared. There is a course in pedagogy for the junior and senior years, but this is optional with the student. There are four elective subjects for each semester for the juniors and the seniors, including pedagogy, and the student is required to take only one of them.

FRESHMAN YEAR Required subjects: First semester—English, Algebra, Physical Geography. Elect one subject. Second semester—English, Algebra, Geometry. Elect one subject.

JUNIOR YEAR Required subjects: First semester—American Literature, Plane Geometry, Physics. Elect one subject. Second semester—American Literature, Solid Geometry, Physics. Elect one subject.

SENIOR YEAR Required subjects: First semester—English Literature, American History. Elect two subjects. Second semester—English Literature, American History. Elect two subjects.

BIG SHOOT BEGINS TODAY AT SEA GIRL

Sea Girl, N. J., Sept. 4.—Of scarcely less importance to the military world than the great national matches recently held at Camp Perry, are those which began on the Sea Girl ranges today and will continue through the whole of next week. In addition to the annual matches of the New Jersey Rifle Association, those of the New York State Rifle Association and the United States Revolver Association are to be held at the same time. The Sea Girl range has always been a Mecca for ambitious marksmen, and this year a program has been arranged which for richness and attractiveness compares favorably with any ever shot.

Many of the teams that recently competed at Camp Perry are here to take part in the various matches. Cuba and the Philippines, in addition to nearly all the states, are represented. For the first time the rifles with which the army and the national guard were recently equipped, together with the new United States ammunition, will be used in contests in this country, and the results will be of importance in determining their value.

The most important match will be for the Dryden trophy, a magnificent piece of bronze, presented by ex-Senator Dryden, to be competed for by teams of eight from the same branches of the military service eligible to the National Trophy match. It is shot at 200, 600 and 1,000 yards. The trophy carries with it cash prizes of from \$50 to \$150. The interstate regimental match for the Briggs trophy, presented by Senator Briggs of New Jersey, will be shot at the same distance by teams of six. With this trophy goes a medal to each man on the winning team, with a cash prize to the second, third and fourth teams.

The matches of the New York State Rifle Association are headed by the company team match at 200, 500 and 600 yards, open to teams of four. Another leading event will be the Thurston match, at 800 and 900 yards, open to everybody. The program of the United States Revolver Association comprises four great matches. The first is the championship match for any revolver which carries with it the championship of the United States, together with the championship cup. The second is the any pistol championship match, also for a silver cup and the pistol championship. The third is the military revolver championship match, which carries the title of champion, and the fourth is the military revolver match, with unlimited entries. All of these matches are regarded as very difficult, as they require as many as fifty shots and at fifty yards' distance.

OREGON BRIDE TURNS OF MISERLY HUSBAND

Phoenix, Ariz., Sept. 2.—Six weeks ago there was a local sensation in the marriage of D. W. Sparks, capitalist, aged 72 years, and Mrs. W. M. Davidson, aged 65. The bride came from Albany, Or., brought by glowing letters that promised a comfortable home and happiness in her declining years.

Night before last another sensation materialized in the departure of the bride for her former home. She was accompanied as far as the railway station by Sparks, where she publicly denounced him as miserly and mean, abusive and unfeeling. Though preparing to take the train she lacked money enough to reach Albany, but the deficiency was quickly made up by a hurried collection by a policeman at the Southern Pacific depot. One witness was so indignant that he threatened personal violence upon Sparks, but the deserted bridegroom made no reply and quietly disappeared.

Mrs. Sparks dramatically refused her husband's request that she write to him and told him that she would never return, as she had become tired of living on hot air and promises.
