San Pedro, Sept. 5.—The steam schooner Shna-Yak, Captain Hutton, arrived here today from Port Hadlock, and reports that on the afternoon of September 1 she went on dangerous rocks at Point Arena, in a

dense fog, but was saved from destruction by the prompt work of the officers and crew. Captain Hutton ordered the deck lashings cut and three thousand feet of lumber was jettisoned, carrying several of the crew to sea with it. Boats were lowered and all were picked up. First Officer Paulson was severely bruised and required medical attention upon his arrival here.

Bidders are required to state the price in detail, in accordance with the specifications. Separate contracts will be awarded to the lowest bidder for the grading and for the graveling of said street. The earthwork shall be completed within thirty days and the graveling within sixty days from the date of letting the contracts therefor.

An approved bond will be required to be furnished by each contractor for the faithful performance of the contract. A certified check in a sum equal to five per cent of the amount bid, payable to J.
