J. J. Chetwood, a farmer, while driving along Pearl street about noon today, was thrown from his hack and seriously injured. Soon they were unmanageable and threw Mr. Chetwood out. Several people residing in the vicinity who witnessed the occurrence at once ran to his assistance and found him unconscious. He was carried into the residence of L. E. Ward at 783 Pearl street and a physician sent for. Later he was removed to the Eugene hospital, where it was found that he was injured internally. It is not known yet whether or not the injuries will result fatally.
