"Chic" Perkins will appear at the Eugene theatre in "The Little Prospector" tonight. Following is what the Salem Daily Statesman says of the play:

"Chic" Perkins in "The Little Prospector" was presented to a good house at the Grand last night and received an excellent welcome. She took the house with her breezy, whole-hearted manner. At the close of each act she was given a certain call. She was a girl of the mining camps, a flower in the desert. She was nery to a degree, full of resource in time of danger, and a sure shot. She was ever ready with a irrepressible laugh, and had the audience laughing with her many times. She was tender, and had a true love for her father, who was a "booze fighter."

The play is a melodrama, but not one of the impossible kind. Emotion and villainy are not overdone. There is plenty of comedy in it to please any one. The acts begin light but develop into good dramatic periods at the close. The applause was liberal and spontaneous. There is a rise in the climaxes of the acts until the fourth. The prayer of "Chic" after the murder when her father comes home drunk after selling the Chuck-Luck mine, the accusation of "Chic" after the murder, and the explosion at the mine were all full of excitement. But the last act was more of a comedy than a stern court trial when a life is at stake. It was almost a burlesque which, while extremely funny, was in no sense close to remote reality. The plot is unraveled by a neat trick on the part of the defense that traps the guilty and sets the mountain maid free. The company is well balanced and gave good support.

Mrs. Mattie Perkins, as Mrs. Bridget O'Dowd, did some clever Irish impersonating and was a favorite because of her testy temper and her copious flow of genuine Irish wit. Her pet expression was "Sufferin' Moses" and it took. She seemed natural and a true daughter of the "old sod" merely transplanted.

Dale Devereaux, as Harry Meyers, a Yale man, was satisfactory and played a straightforward part. Sheriff Owens, Jim Baugh, had a most peculiar sepulchral voice, but made
