COTTAGE GROVE WILL HAVE A DISTRICT FAIR

ANNUAL EXHIBITION OF LIVESTOCK AND FARM PRODUCTS WILL BE HELD—RACE COURSE WILL BE ADDED LATER—FIRST FAIR TO BE HELD THIS FALL

One of the annual attractions at Cottage Grove hereafter is to be a county or district fair. Plans were perfected for the annual exhibition of the livestock, poultry, fruits, farm products, minerals, and manufactured articles of southern Lane and northern Douglas counties at a meeting of the Cottage Grove merchants in the Commercial Club rooms Wednesday evening. Grounds were leased for a term of years; plans submitted for the necessary buildings, officers elected and various committees appointed to direct and carry to a successful conclusion the various departments of the fair, the first annual exhibit of which will be held this season about the middle of the coming November, the exact date to be fixed at a meeting of the committees next Tuesday evening.

While a little late for holding the fair this year, there is ordinarily very good weather here up to Thanksgiving time, and owing to the fact that commodious buildings will be provided, a little rain will not seriously interfere with the success of the occasion.

Before another season rolls around a race course will be secured and the usual fair attractions provided. This first exhibit, therefore, will be more of a produce and livestock show, or carnival, than a fair, owing to the lateness of the season.

Notice is hereby given that on the 1st day of October, 1908, at each of the polling places hereinafter named, a special election will be held in and for said City, whereat will be submitted to the legal voters of said City for approval or rejection, A BILL, proposed by the Common Council of the City of Eugene, for a law to amend Sections 108 and 112 of the Charter of the City of Eugene, being Chapter 252, of the laws of the state of Oregon for the year 1905, entitled, "An act to re-incorporate the city of Eugene, and repeal all acts and parts of acts in conflict herewith," filed in the office of the Secretary of State, February 18, 1905, as amended by the people of the City of Eugene April 18, 1908, and to repeal all acts and parts of acts in conflict herewith," and A BILL, proposed by the Common Council of the City of Eugene, for a law to amend Section 109 of the charter of the City of Eugene, being Chapter 252, of the laws of the State of Oregon for the year 1905, entitled, "An act to re-incorporate the City of Eugene, and to repeal all acts and parts of acts in conflict herewith," filed in the office of the Secretary of State, February 18th, 1905, and to repeal all acts and parts of acts in conflict herewith," which said bills were each proposed and ordained by the Common Council of said City July 31st, 1908 and on said day filed with the Recorder of said City, which election will be held at 8 o'clock in the morning and will continue until 7 o'clock in the afternoon of said October 1st, 1908.
