BUILDING PERMITS WERE LIGHT IN SEPTEMBER

TWO BIG BUSINESS BLOCKS STARTED IN THAT MONTH WILL FIGURE IN OCTOBER FOOTINGS—MANY RESIDENCES STARTED LAST MONTH.
