### LARGER SITE FOR COTTAGE GROVE FAIR

At a meeting Friday evening of the various committees to work on the forthcoming harvest fair or carnival at Cottage Grove November 19, 20 and 21, it was the unanimous opinion of the members of these committees that the site selected, facing the high school on Fourth street, would prove inadequate for holding the forthcoming fair, since it is proposed to provide quarters for all kinds of livestock subject to registry and poultry at this first exhibit.

**New Site Selected**

It was therefore voted that the building committee and board of directors be empowered to select and lease for a period of from three to five years a conveniently located tract, if possible, to be used as a site for the annual harvest fair.

J. I. Jones, a member of the exhibit committee, was present at this meeting and generously proposed to donate a tract of land to be used for this purpose on either Fifth or Mill streets. On Saturday forenoon the committees appointed visited these sites and selected the tract on Fifth street just back of James Benson's residence, as the most convenient and most desirable site for holding the fair, and lumber is being placed on the ground rapidly for the necessary sheds and buildings, 40,000 feet having been generously donated by nearby sawmills to be used for this purpose. The fair site is well elevated, well drained, and comprises something over two acres of ground and is only five blocks from the post-office.

**Bigger Thing Than Anticipated**

The committees, to their surprise, have already discovered the fact that this proposed harvest fair is mysteriously developing into a far bigger thing than was anticipated and that they had taken hold of a pretty big proposition, and they find themselves not unlike the Irishman who caught the bear, and wanted to, but dared not "let go."—Leader.

### CANADIAN PACIFIC ISSUES MORE STOCK

Montreal, Oct. 7.—At a meeting held at the general offices in this city today the stockholders of the Canadian Pacific Railway took favorable action in regard to the proposal of the directors for an increase of \$50,000,000 in the common capital stock of the company. The additional stock is to be issued from time to time according to the requirements of the company. The greater part of the issue, it is understood, will be used to carry out the plans of the road for the development of its steamship lines, not only on the Pacific, but on the Atlantic as well.
