### PROCLAMATION

I, J. D. Matlock, mayor of the city of Eugene, hereby notify the people of the city of Eugene, and proclaim that the bill proposed by the common council and referred to the people, to amend Sections 108 and 112 of the Charter of the City of Eugene, as amended by the people of said city April 18, 1903, by giving the Common Council the power and authority to issue and sell five per cent negotiable water bonds of the city to a sum not exceeding \$500,000 in the aggregate, failed to receive a majority of the votes cast thereon at the special election held in the city of Eugene on the first day of October, 1908, and therefore failed to become a law of the City of Eugene, the majority against the same being 158 votes.

That the bill proposed by the Common Council and referred to the people for amending Section 108 of the Charter of the City of Eugene, so as to empower the Common Council in the sale of the water bonds of the city when no bids are received for the purchase thereof at or above par at the time advertised; then the Council may negotiate and sell the said bonds or any part thereof at private sale at not less than their par value without readvertising; submitted to the vote of the people of the City of Eugene at the first day of October, 1908, received a majority of the votes cast thereon as follows: Number of voters voting in favor of said amendment, 425; voting against said amendment, 346; majority in favor of said amendment, 79; and thereby became a law of the city of Eugene.

### COUNCIL HOLDS AN ADJOURNED SESSION

A meeting of the city council was held last night, the council adjourning Monday night to meet for the purpose of discussing the matter of securing a site for a new city hall. This matter was not considered at the regular business meeting last night, but was discussed in committee of the whole, which was held after the meeting adjourned.

The remonstrance against grading and graveling the alleys in block 5, Skinner's addition to Eugene, was read, but was laid over for further examination.

A vote of thanks was tendered the Willamette Valley Company for installing an arc light in the council chamber free of charge to the city.

A petition to vacate an alley between Fourteenth and Fifteenth streets was tabled.

The street committee reported that the Huddleston estate agreed to give such ground as is necessary to straighten out West Eighth street, and within a year would dedicate Monroe street, through their land south of Eighth street. The report was adopted and the city attorney instructed to prepare a contract for such deed of dedication.

The sewer committee reported on the sewer in the alley west of Jefferson street two blocks, between Eleventh and Twelfth streets, and the contract for building it was let to E. R. Mumme, who was the lowest bidder, for \$550.

Warrants were ordered drawn as rebates for parties wrongfully assessed on East Eighth street for paving.

The canvassing board made its report on the bond vote as previously published—the majority being defeated by 158 majorities, and the other amendment carried by 79 majorities.
