GREAT HUNT TAKES PLACE NEXT WEEK

Lawton, Okla., Oct. 10.—This city and vicinity is to be the scene during the coming week of a notable and interesting gathering on the occasion of the annual meet of the League of American Sportsmen. For eight days the sharp crack of the hunter's rifle and the deep bay of the faithful hound will resound over hill and dale while the wolf and bear and other beasts of prey are run to cover.

The League of American Sportsmen numbers among its members hundreds of crack shots scattered throughout every section of the country. Last year scores of hunters participated in the annual meet and much game was killed. This year the hunt has been more extensively advertised, and even a larger number of sportsmen are expected to participate. Hundreds of sportsmen will be here from Oklahoma, Texas, Arkansas, Kansas and other southwestern states, and New York, Pennsylvania, Ohio, Illinois, Iowa and other states more distant will be represented. A delegation from Colorado and the West will also be on hand.

The Lawton Chamber of Commerce has completed elaborate plans for the entertainment of the visitors. The program provides for several days of amusements of various sorts immediately following the business convention, including trap shooting contests, quail hunting, wolf chasing and rabbit drives, trips to Fort Sill and the Wichita national game preserves. The game preserves in the Wichita mountains are well stocked with buffalo and deer and it is planned eventually to make the preserve one of the finest in the country. Eight thousand acres of the park have been completely fenced in by the government at a cost of \$15,000. The fence is fourteen feet high, built of strongly woven wire, and was constructed with the view of retaining any kind of game of valuable size, while the immense tract of land which it encloses gives ample room for the freedom of the animals.
