## OPERATIONS TO RESUME AT THE LUCKY BOY MINE

A report comes to The Guard from Blue River that the Lucky Boy mine, which was recently sold at referee's sale, will be operated again soon, and that preparations are now being made to begin the work of getting the plant in order. An expert from Portland is there now looking over the property to see what repairs and alterations are necessary. It is reported that a load of concentrates is shipped on the way to Eugene to be shipped to the Tacoma smelter. An English syndicate now has control of the property and they are represented by the Sunstake-Lyman Company, of Portland. It is said that the new company will furnish electric power and light to the other mine owners in the district, something that the old company would not do. This will be a great thing for the district and will be a means of developing it faster, as heretofore the Lucky Boy people controlled practically all the power and the smaller owners were handicapped on that account.
