CHOLERA TAKES SCORES OF HOGS IN LANE COUNTY

Junction City, Oct. 25.—Hog cholera has made its appearance in this section. The first instance was noted among hogs belonging to J. E. S. Nielson. He lost nine head. A few days later the herd of F. W. Thorne, who lives two miles from Mr. Nielson, contracted the disease, and 20 head were lost. At present the plague is ravaging the large band of fat hogs belonging to Hon. C. W. Washburn. To date he has lost 34 head and more are dying every day.

The state veterinary surgeon was here a few days ago and he pronounced it to be cholera in its most violent form. He advised that all hogs having it should be killed and burned, which is now being done. It is not known how the disease gained a foothold here, as there has been no foreign breed brought in.

NEW SAWMILL BEING BUILT AT SMITHFIELD

Smithfield is to have a new sawmill. The building is already up and the engine and machinery were hauled this week. Mr. Umphrey bought the Mount 320 acres of timber near that place, and Mr. Mount is to deliver it at the mill for \$2.50 per thousand. His mill will be equipped with a planer and moulder, and will be in condition therefore to furnish all kinds of building material. If a good article of finished lumber is turned out we do not see why the entire output cannot be disposed of at once. It will be the nearest mill to this place, and the lumber that has been ordered from our mill requires from four weeks to four months to get it.—Junction City Times.
